## Qualifications and preferences

#### 1. Qualifications

- Candidates should hold a Ph. D. degree in Materials Science and Engineering or a related field by the start of employment.
- \*[Candidates who expect to earn the doctorate degree should be able to pass the final thesis examination (must arrange a confirmation letter from his/her thesis advisor) within 9 months since the date of application submission]
- Candidates should be able to teach courses in English. Not only research achievements but also teaching skills will be equally considered.

#### 2. Preferences

- Female and foreign applicants

## Selection Procedures

- 1<sup>st</sup> : Review of application packages
- 2<sup>nd</sup> : In-depth examination by the Department's search committee
- 3<sup>rd</sup> : Seminar at the Department and interviews with faculty members
- 4<sup>th</sup> : Final appointment decision after the review by the Faculty Personnel Committee in the College of Engineering and by the Headquarters Faculty Personnel Committee
- \* Only applicants who pass each review process will be notified individually and invited to the next round.

■ Application period: February 17, 2025 (Mon.) - March 16, 2025 (Sun.)

- Copies of five representative papers (applicants may provide additional papers if they wish)
- Letters of recommendation (only those who pass the initial screening of application packages will be asked for recommendation letters. Recommenders must send the letter directly to <u>msehead@kaist.ac.kr</u>).
  - . Submit a total of Three (3) copies if candidate apply as an Assistant Professor or an Associate Professor.
  - . Submit a total of Six (6) copies if candidate apply as a Tenure Track/Full Professor.

## Additional notes

- Care should be taken not to reveal any personal information that may bias reviewers of application packages. Examples of the personal information include gender, age, region of origin, family relationships, physical characteristics (e.g., height, weight, and photo), assets, and marital status.
- When there is no qualified candidate, hiring will be postponed to the next round.
- The submitted documents shall not be returned to applicants. If the submitted documents contained false information, the appointment recommendation may be revoked.
