## **JOB QUALIFICATIONS:**

Candidates must have a Ph.D. degree or be in the final stage of their dissertation, and be qualified to teach finance courses at undergraduate and graduate levels.

## **SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT:**

It is located in Seoul, Korea and is an AACSB-accredited school with leading MBA and Executive Programs as well as academically-oriented Master and Ph.D. programs. Both our faculty members and PhD students pursue high quality research, and their recent publications appear in top finance journals such as *Journal of Finance, Journal of Financial Economics*, and the *Review of Financial Studies*. We provide an excellent research environment that includes a low teaching load (6 credit hours per year for the first 3 years, and then 6 to 9 credit hours per year based on individual preference), active seminar series, and subscriptions of the voluminous database widely used by finance academics/practitioners mostly with the WRDS platform and the Bloomberg terminal. In addition, our school offers a comprehensive and generous fringe benefit package including faculty campus housing (free for the first two years) and substantial start-up research funds, which can be used in part to cover moving expenses from around the world.
