Tenure-Track Position Announcement

The College of Business at the Korea Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (KAIST) invites applications for two tenure-track positions in the field of Information Systems. The appointment will commence in Fall 2025. The requirements for this position are: (a) a Ph.D. degree in Information Systems, Economics, Computer Science, Statistics, or related fields; (b) a publication record in top-tier academic journals commensurate with experience; and (c) evidence of teaching effectiveness. The candidate must have completed their doctorate by the time of appointment and demonstrate outstanding potential for research. Applicants for the rank of Associate Professor should have an outstanding record of research productivity. KAIST College of Business is a graduate-only program, and the successful candidate will be expected to teach graduate-level courses. For new faculty members, the typical teaching load is one course per semester, and each will have their own research lab. While we welcome candidates with a broad range of interests, the ideal candidate would have an interest in teaching and conducting research in the quantitative and technical areas, including but not limited to *Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning, AI-based Business Applications, Business/Data Analytics*, and *Economics of IS*.

KAIST College of Business was included in the 'Top 100 Global MBA' list and ranked 20th in the 2024 'Executive Education Ranking' by the *Financial Times*. Located in Seoul, Republic of Korea, it is an AACSB-accredited institution with leading MBA and Executive Programs, as well as academically oriented Master's and Ph.D. programs. Our faculty members and Ph.D. students engage in high-quality research, with recent publications appearing in top journals such as *MIS Quarterly*, *Information Systems Research*, *Management Science*, *Marketing Science*, *Journal of Marketing Research*, and *Production and Operations Management*. We provide an excellent research environment with a low teaching load (6 credit hours per year for the first three years, and then 6 to 9 credit hours per year based on individual preference) and an active seminar series. In addition, our school offers a comprehensive and generous fringe benefits package, including faculty campus housing and substantial start-up research funds, which can partly cover moving expenses from anywhere in the world. science and technology, such as the Graduate School of AI.
